ANTI-BULLY RAFFLE RULES

Disclaimer Language:

This Christmas in July raffle ("The Raffle") is conducted by Win-Win Resolutions ("Win-Win"), a not-for-profit corporation organized under the laws of the State of North Carolina. These Rules ("The Rules") govern The Raffle and, by purchasing a raffle ticket or collecting a prize from a ticket purchased in your name, you agree to be bound by these Rules.

1. The Raffle is open only to legal residents of the United States who are 18 years of age or older as of June 10, 2013. Tickets cannot be sold outside of the boundaries of the State of North Carolina. Residency of another state shall not prevent entry into this contest. Employees, board members of Win-Win and members of their household or immediate family members (defined as parent, spouse, child, sibling, or grandparent) are NOT eligible to enter The Raffle.
2. This Raffle begins on June 10, 2013 and ends on July 25, 2013, or when all tickets have been sold, whichever comes first. The drawing for the winner will be held on July 25, 2013.
3. The purchase of a raffle ticket is necessary to enter or win. There is no entry limit per person. Refunds will not be issued.
4. No more than 400 tickets will be sold. If 400 tickets are sold before the closing date, The Raffle will officially close, and any funds turned in after The Raffle closes will be returned to the payor. All tickets will be recorded in the order received.
5. The purchase price for one raffle ticket is \$50.00. If an entrant's check is dishonored by their bank, the entry ticket will be invalid unless full payment is received by Win-Win by July 25, 2013.
6. The entrant's chances of winning will never be worse than 1 in 400.
7. The Grand Prize for the winner of The Raffle will be three quarters of the value of the number of tickets sold. The Runner-Up Prize for the 2nd winner of The Raffle will be one quarter of the value of the number of tickets sold. The maximum raffle prize allowed under North Carolina law is \$10,000. The remaining proceeds will benefit Win-Win.
8. The Winner will be determined by random drawing. The drawing will take place on July 25, 2013 at approximately 6:00pm Eastern Standard Time at Glenwood Recreation Center located at 2110 Coliseum Blvd. in Greensboro, NC. The winner need not be present and the winner will be notified by telephone and mail.

9. Raffle ticket purchases are not tax deductible and winnings are taxable. The winner is responsible for all state and federal taxes and the winner will hold Win-Win harmless for any taxes owed. Raffle winnings are reportable to the IRS as gambling winnings if the value of the winnings is a) \$600 or more, and b) at least 300 times the amount of the wager. Winnings less than \$600 are also considered gambling winnings by the winner, however, Win-Win is not required to report these winnings to the IRS. It is required that Win-Win obtain the name, address and social security number of the winner. Failure to obtain this information will subject the winner to a higher withholding tax rate, referred to as the backup withholding rate. Win-Win will report winnings on IRS Form W-2G. A copy of this statement will be furnished to the winner by January 31st of the following year, and a copy will also be furnished to the IRS. If the value of the winnings is greater than \$5,000 Win-Win is required to withhold and remit income tax to the IRS in an amount determined by the winner's individual tax bracket, which ranges from 28% to 31%.
10. Purchasers of raffle tickets must provide their full names, addresses and telephone numbers. The Raffle will only recognize one entrant per raffle ticket. Win-Win shall, will and can have no obligation for payment or delivery of any prize to any person other than the entrant. It is the sole responsibility of the entrant to allocate any such prize among the participants in any multiple party entry.
11. The winner of the raffle must claim the prize within 90 days of the drawing. If the winner does not claim the prize within 90 days of the drawing, by responding to telephonic or written notice, the prize will be forfeited and will be retained by and benefit Win-Win.
12. Any drawing may be postponed due to weather or any state of emergency declared by the Mayor of Greensboro, NC, the County of Guilford, NC, the Governor of North Carolina, or the President of the United States. In such event, a new date, place and time for the drawing will be determined, which will be announced to the media, posted at Win-Win Resolution's office and posted on Win-Win Resolution's website.
13. Any and all disputes, claims and controversies concerning this raffle shall be governed by North Carolina law.
14. By participating in the Raffle and/or accepting a prize, the entrant consents to and gives Win-Win the right to interview, photograph or video a winner, and in perpetuity to freely and exclusively use, publish, and display a winner's (and where applicable a participant's) names, picture, portrait, likeness, voice, video, statements, quotes, and prize information in, whole or in part, for advertising, trade, publicity and promotional purposes in any media now known or hereafter discovered, worldwide, and on the World Wide Web, without review, notification or approval, all without additional consideration, unless prohibited by law. Entries will not be acknowledged or returned.

15. Participants agree that by participating in the Raffle they release Win-Win from any Liability in connection with:
 - a. entries that are ineligible as a result of being lost, late, illegible, damaged, incomplete, stolen or misdirected;
 - b. any typographical or other human or technical errors in the offer or administration of the Raffle, including but not limited to errors in advertising, these official rules, the selection and announcement of a winner(s), or the distribution/awarding of a prize(s);
 - c. acts of God, natural disasters, or other force majeure matters out of Win-Win's control.

16. Win-Win reserves the right to modify these rules for clarification purposes without materially affecting the terms and conditions of the Raffle.

17. If for any reason the Raffle is not capable of running as planned as a result of but not limited to an error, omission, defect, delay, misdirection, tampering, unauthorized intervention, fraud, action of entrants, infection by a computer virus, technical failure, natural disaster, act of God, disruption of the public markets, act of terrorism, war or any other cause which in the sole opinion of Win-Win corrupts or affects the administration, security, fairness, integrity, or proper conduct of the Raffle, Win-Win reserves the right at its sole discretion to withdraw, cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the Raffle without obligation or prior notice and in such event to determine the winner via random drawing from among all valid entries received up to the time of such cancellation, termination, modification or suspension. In such event, Win-Win shall have no liability to any participant who is disqualified due to such an action. Failure to enforce any term of these official rules shall not constitute a waiver of that provision.
